A contractor requested clarification on the two points below:

Q: In regards to the asbestos abatement at the Federal Street apartments. Is it the responsibility of the Asbestos Abatement contractor to remove the non-asbestos floor tile and mastic from the apartments?

A: Yes. Please refer to General Demolition Notes (specifically #1), the asbestos abatement contractor is responsible for the removal and disposal of the non-AC flooring and associated mastic to slab or sub flooring.

Q: In the asbestos spec section it says to install a ½” ball valve shut off, would this be the responsibility of the asbestos abatement contractor?

A: Yes. Please refer to Asbestos Removal Notes (specifically WV), the asbestos abatement contractor is responsible for installing of one new ½” full brass ball valve or equivalent water shut off valve. Also, please refer to the Asbestos Removal and Disposal Specification Section: 1.3 Special Conditions.
